Mr. Thomas J. Dunaway assumed the role of Project Manager for Terrestrial Sensors in June 2026. In this capacity, he leads an organization responsible for the development, procurement, fielding, training, and sustainment of advanced ground sensor capabilities that enhance Army surveillance, reconnaissance, target acquisition, and multidomain operational effectiveness.

Mr. Dunaway previously served as a Project Officer within the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics and Technology (ASA[ALT]) Operations team at the Pentagon. In this role, he coordinated enterprise-level operational activities and supported senior leader decision-making across the Army acquisition enterprise, including the development of the ASA[ALT] Operations Center, designed to improve real-time situational awareness, integration, and executive decision support.

From 2021 to 2024, Mr. Dunaway served as a Centralized Selection List Product Manager for Global Enterprise Network Modernization–OCONUS within the Integrated Enterprise Network portfolio. He led a globally dispersed workforce of more than 100 personnel responsible for delivering secure communications and unified network capabilities across U.S. Africa Command, Central Command, European Command, and Indo-Pacific Command. Under his leadership, the organization enhanced the resiliency, security, and operational effectiveness of the Army's united network infrastructure, strengthening mission command, improving interoperability with Joint and coalition partners, and enabling Combatant Commanders to execute operations across multiple theaters. His efforts directly advanced Army network modernization priorities and increased the readiness of forward-stationed and deployed forces worldwide.

Mr. Dunaway's previous assignments include key leadership positions both CONUS and OCONUS within Program Executive Office Enterprise Information Systems (PEO EIS) and Program Executive Office Command, Control, and Communications-Tactical (PEO C3T), where he was responsible for complex portfolios spanning global communications, infrastructure modernization, and enterprise IT services. During his military career, he served in numerous operational leadership roles in the 2nd Battalion, 4th Field Artillery Regiment, including Multiple Launch Rocket System (MLRS) Platoon Leader (with deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom), Executive Officer, Battalion Maintenance Officer, and Battalion Logistics Officer.

Mr. Dunaway's awards and honors include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Civilian Service Medal, the Civilian Service Commendation Medal, and multiple Army Achievement Medals. He is a member of the Army Acquisition Corps and holds Advanced Certification in Program Management.
